On behalf of PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC, AECOM conducted Phase I archaeological survey on previously unsurveyed portions of the newly proposed Church Road Interconnects (Interconnects) in Bethlehem Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania.

The purpose of the Interconnects is to allow PennEast to construct the Project in two phases. The Phase 1 facilities would include all Project facilities from MP 0.0R1 (northern terminus) to MP 68.2R3 and the Church Road Interconnects; Phase 2 facilities would include all Project facilities from MP 68.2R3 to 114.01R3 and the Transco Receiver Site (southern terminus).

The proposed Interconnects would be an approximately 2.13-acre Metering and Regulation Station at the Project's mainline pipeline intersection with existing Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC and Adelphia Gateway, LLC pipelines. The potential workspace for the Interconnects measures approximately ~5.93 acres, which serves as the APE for the Interconnects. An Archaeological Negative Survey Form (NSF) documenting the results of that survey has been uploaded to the Cultural Resources Geographic Information System for your review and comment. No archaeological sites were identified. AECOM respectfully requests PA SHPO's concurrence that no additional Phase I survey is required for the proposed Interconnects.
